In the context of health care, activities that take place in peripheral health centers, The healthcare activities of the peripheral health centers are carried out in a systematic manner by preparing a work schedule. Primary healthcare is provided at each location on a weekly basis by a group consisting of qualified medical officers, practice nurses, interns, and supporting people, sometimes known as dispensing staff. By providing transportation services, the facility allows the medical staff to go to and from the institution as well as to areas that are farther away. Routine medical operations that are performed in peripheral health facilities include obtaining a patient's medical history, doing physical exams, making diagnoses, and prescribing medicine. Free medical treatment is provided by the organization in a variety of settings, including households, orphanages, centers for the mentally disabled, and tribal settings. At the other facilities, a nominal fee, ranging from five to twenty rupees, is collected. In addition to this, it organizes activities that are beneficial to health, such as health and sanitation, the distribution of leaflets, and the raising of awareness about preventive measures.

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
recorded in the registers, and the data that is produced on an annual basis indicates that this group is showing an increasing trend.
